Return to School

School is open from 8am every day and a free breakfast of fresh fruit, toasted bagels and cereal is available at no cost.

Summer Safety

With the summer approaching we wanted to offer advice about safeguarding over the summer with a particular focus on online safety. In addition to this letter, we have attached some posters with additional advice that you might find helpful about general online safety.

Students need a level of maturity to be able to manage the pressures that can be attached to Social Media. Students need to think carefully about what they post online to prevent issues such as bullying, discrimination, prejudice and unkindness.

Please could we ask that parents/carers regularly check phones. Software is available that would allow you to monitor your child's phone and devices and we strongly advocate the use of this when pupils are under 16.

As parents/carers you will understand that our role in supporting children is to help them understand how to use the internet safely and to build the interpersonal skills that allow them to flourish as active and responsible global citizens. We have spoken to students extensively about online safety and ask for parent/carer support in ensuring our students are safe online at home.
